

# Welcome to the Bellister Estate

Bellister Castle circular walk 2½ miles



In May Bellister Wood is carpeted with bluebells.



This short circular walk takes you through woods, across fields and along the river.

You can see ruins of the castle from many points on this walk.

It is said to be haunted by the 'Grey Man' the ghost of a minstrel killed by the Lord of Bellister's hunting dogs.

Another legend tells of seven 'bold moss troopers' hanged from a sycamore on the castle mound.



Bellister Castle - this part of the castle is a house built in Victorian times. The ruins on the left are 14th century. The castle mound was built around 1100.
